He received his degree as doctor of Environmental Sciences/Toxicology at University of Wageningen in 1988, following the preparation of doctoral thesis at the German Cancer Research Centre (DKFZ) Heidelberg (Germany); 1979 – 1985 Study of Environmental Hygiene/Toxicology, University of Wageningen, Netherlands.

He worked for 34 years at BASF SE, Ludwigshafen, the last 20 as Senior Vice President of the Department for Experimental Toxicology and Ecology, which included as of 2019 BASF Metabolome Solutions, former Metanomics GmbH.

He is an associate professor for Reproduction Toxicity of the University of Wageningen since 2012 and had a teaching assignment at the University of Kaiserslautern (for industrial toxicology) from 2006 until 2021.

He is Chairman of the scientific committee of the European Centre for Ecotoxicology and Toxicology (ECETOC). Moreover, he is member of editorial boards of "Archives of Toxicology", "Chemical Biological Interactions" and "Toxicology Letters.

He was member of the board of trustees of Health and Environment Science Institute (HESI) from 2012 – 2018.

He is a Member of the German Society for Pharmacology and Toxicology, a European registered toxicologist and SOT-Member.

He is an author of 250 peer reviewed papers.

Since January 2022 he is an independent consultant for environmental sciences.
